

INFORMATION: The start of Nattvasan 45 will be moved

It's almost time for your race in forefathers' tracks; a warm welcome to Nattvasan 45! The mild and snowless winter has had consequences for Vasaloppet's Winter Week and we want to inform you that the start of Nattvasan 45 will be moved from Oxberg to Evertsberg. This is so we can focus our snow work along the classic Vasaloppet track and prioritize our efforts there. As a consequence, Nattvasan 45 will be 43 km long this year instead of 45 km. Of course the race will still be part of Vasaloppstrippeln 45 for 2020 and En Svensk Klassiker Halva.

What does this mean for me?

The Start

Train and prepare as planned! The joint start for all teams will be at 20:00 on Friday, February 28. The start is divided into three start groups and group assignment is based on the estimated finishing time you entered when registering. You'll be able to enter the start area from 18:30 and on. Be there no later than 19:45. The cut-off times for the race remain the same.

Busses to the start

Those who have booked a bus to the start in Oxberg will get on as planned and be transported directly to the new start in Evertsberg. Those who haven't booked a bus yet are advised to do so soon in order to conveniently get to the start. The price is the same as before and as usual it's cheaper to buy the ticket in advance at vasaloppet.se but you can also buy your ticket on location.

Busses to the Evertsberg start in Nattvasan 45 will depart from Mora and Sälen at 18:00 according to the same timetable as before.

Parking

There is limited parking available in Evertsberg. If you're driving to the start, go directly to the new start in Evertsberg and park there. After the finish in Mora there will be busses running back to Evertsberg.

Number bib and chip

We encourage you and other participants to collect your number bibs at the number bib distribution in Sälen or Mora. On Friday, February 28 the number bib distribution in Mora is open 10:00–19:00 and in Sälen 06:00–21:00. But you can collect your number bib as early as Sunday, February 23. If necessary you can also collect your number bib directly at the Evertsberg start (opening at 18:00) shortly before you start the race.
